- GIRLS**
- Jumpers** are worn by Grades K3 through Grade 5.
Wilson Plaid Jumper (in-house stock)
Classic Navy Jumper (Lands' End, item #068176)
- Skirts** are worn by girls in Grades 6, 7, and 8.
Wilson Plaid Skirt (in-house stock)
Classic Navy Pleated Skirt (Lands' End, item #430797)
- Shirts:** Long or short sleeved turtleneck, polo shirt with collar, or blouse with collar in white, clear red, or navy blue. **Shirts must be tucked in at all times.**
- Socks:** Plain knee-highs, tights, leggings, or anklets in the following colors: solid white or navy blue. **Socks are required.**
- Sweaters:** Solid white, clear red or navy blue in any style (pullover, cardigan, V-neck, sweater vest). **Sweatshirts are not permitted.**
- Shoes:** Brown or black leather, or gym shoes may be worn; clogs are not permitted.
- Other:** Make-up and nail polish are not permitted. No jewelry or earrings, other than ear-studs, are permitted. No sweatpants are to be worn under the school uniform during the regular school hours with the exception of recess.
- BOYS**
- Pants:** Navy dress pants (twill), navy corduroy pants, or khaki colored pants. **Cargo pants and jeans are not permitted.**
- Shirts:** Long or short sleeved turtleneck, polo shirt with collar, dress shirt with collar in white, clear red, or navy. **Shirts must be tucked in at all times.**
- Shorts:** Navy or khaki walking shorts are permitted only during the months of September, May, and June.
- Socks:** Plain navy or white socks are required to be worn.
- Sweaters:** Solid white, clear red or navy blue in any style (pullover, cardigan, V-neck, or sweater vest). **Sweatshirts are not permitted.**
- Shoes:** Brown or black leather shoes, or gym shoes may be worn.
- Hair:** A traditional hair cut is required. Boys' hair must be trimmed above the collar.

**Student and parental support is expected in the very important matter of dress decorum.
