



Quarantine FAQ Sheet

When should I keep my child home?

Self-Quarantine:

- If your child has a fever, cough or cold or flu-like symptoms (until symptoms subside).
- If your child or a family member have come into contact with anyone who has tested positive for the Coronavirus (5 days from contact date).
- Please inform the Main Office if your child needs to self-quarantine.
- Your child may continue to participate in class through remote learning, if their health allows.

School Quarantine:

- If your child becomes unwell during the school day, their temperature will be taken in the Main Office, and they will remain outside of class until they are picked up by a parent.
- Unwell children waiting to be picked up will wait in the Office.
- Children who test positive for the Coronavirus must quarantine at home for a period of 5 days, and 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever.

- If a student in your child's class tests positive for the Coronavirus, we will recommend a period of monitoring to determine your child's well-being.

We encourage additional rest and fresh air for our students throughout the school year, in order to keep their immune systems and their spirits strong!
